Biography

Arthur C. Berdahl was born on September 26, 1906, in South Dakota. In 1927 he received an A.B. at Augustana College and an M.A. and Ph.D. at the State University of Iowa (now the University of Iowa) in 1931 and 1936, respectively. During the summer sessions of 1930 to 1934 he taught music at the State University of Iowa and in the summer of 1936 he conducted the symphony orchestra there.

Berdahl came to Fresno State Teachers College (now California State University, Fresno) in 1932 to teach music. During his time at Fresno State, he formed the Fresno State College Symphony Orchestra, which performed free concerts from 1932 to 1954. From 1943 to 1955 he was the head of the Music department. After stepping down as head of the department, he taught Music Theory and Music Appreciation and continued to conduct the college orchestra. In 1952, he performed his oratorio *Judas Iscariot*, to celebrate his 20th year of teaching at Fresno State. He retired from teaching in 1970.

Outside of teaching, he was also very involved with music in the community. In 1939, Berdahl became the director of the Fresno Symphony Orchestra. Later, in 1954, the Fresno Philharmonic Orchestra was formed. This orchestra was an extension of Berdahl's college and community orchestras. He was also the musical director of the Central California Symphony Association.

Arthur C. Berdahl died in Fresno on June 19, 1989.

Scope and Content Note

The Arthur C. Berdahl papers measure 7.5 linear feet and date from 1924 to 1989.

The Class notes contain handouts about music that Berdahl used as teaching supplements for his Music Theory and Music Appreciation classes.

The Compositions were all written by Berdahl and include the sketches and drafts for each song before it was finished. Some of the songs were published and have copyrights reserved for Berdahl. The composition that Berdahl is most renowned for is his oratorio *Judas Iscariot*. Included is a complete set of individual orchestra parts for *Judas Iscariot*. A complete bound score of the song is also included and is shelved in oversize box 7.

The Concert and performance programs are from pieces that Berdahl conducted, performed in, or directed. These range from performances at various churches, the Fresno Philharmonic Orchestra, Fresno State College, the State University of Iowa, and the Fresno

Symphony Orchestra.

Included in Correspondence are various letters to and from Berdahl that pertain to his music. Some of the letters are to music publishers, to whom Berdahl wrote in the hope of getting his music compositions published.

The *Hockett-Cowan Hour* was a radio show that Berdahl put on weekly. He was the spokesman for the show.

There is an interview done with Berdahl in 1976 on reel-to-reel tapes.

The Recordings contain records and reel-to-reel magnetic tapes of songs by Berdahl.

The Scores and songbooks are from published sources that he later used in composing his own songs and include notes made by Berdahl.

The Scrapbooks primarily contains newspaper clippings and pictures that Berdahl acquired over the years. Included are newspaper articles about the basketball team that he coached and other articles pertaining to things outside of his professional career. Berdahl's funeral announcement is laid in one of the scrapbooks.
