Biography

Russell Fey was born on March 12, 1926. In 1948 he graduated from Hiram College in Ohio with a B.A. in sociology and received an M.A. in city and regional planning at University of California, Berkeley in 1958. Later, in 1982, he received an M.A. in history at University of California, Riverside. In 1969, Fey came to Fresno State College (now California State University, Fresno) to teach classes on historic preservation and urban and regional planning. He also wrote a few manuals on the historic preservation of buildings.

Outside of his teaching career, Fey was very involved with the city of Fresno. Because of his passion for preserving historic buildings, especially in the Valley, Fey served on various historic preservation committees including the Fresno Planning Commission from 1977 to 1979, the Fresno City Historical Preservation Commission from 1990 until his death in 1996, and the Fresno City and County Historical Society Board. He was also the city planning director for the city of Modesto.

Russell Fey died on April 4, 1996, at the age of 70.

Scope and Content Note

The Russell Fey papers measure 3.25 linear feet and date from 1969 to 1986. The papers are arranged in two series: Personal and Professional. The bulk of the collection concerns Fey's teaching career at California State University, Fresno.

The **Personal** series (1974-1983) includes letters that Fey received and also includes a few papers that he wrote while working on his M.A. in history at the University of California, Riverside in 1982.

The **Professional** series (1969-1986) predominantly contains Fey's teaching materials such as lecture notes, student papers and student notes on field trips, organized by course number and semester. Some of the teaching materials are in binders. The contents of each binder are in their original order. The series also contains information from conferences about historic preservation that Fey attended throughout his teaching career.

Related Collections

Russell Fey wrote several guides and manuals about the historic preservation of buildings in the San Joaquin Valley and the Fresno area. These can be found in ALIS and are available for checkout in the main stacks of the library.
