WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR A FREE PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS (K-12) BORROWER'S CARD?

- Full-time, certified public school teachers (K-12).
- Applicants must have a **brief letter** stating they are a permanent, full-time, certified public school teacher (K-12). The letter should be on official school stationery and must be signed by the building principal or the building principal's administrative assistant.
- Applicants must have a current California driver's license or California identification card.
- Applicants must provide their Social Security number.

PRIVILEGES

- Teachers may borrow a total of 30 items. They may borrow up to 5 items from each of the following: Madden Library general collection; Teacher Resource Center (TRC) media and hands on collection (models, artifacts, kits, games, etc.); TRC teacher tools collection (AVerVision document camera, Califone listening center, laptop speaker, recording equipment, etc.); Music & Media; and Maps & Government Information.
- Up to 20 items may be borrowed from the TRC general collection.
- The loan period for general collection and Teacher Resource Center materials is 28 days; the loan period for other materials may vary.

RENEWALS

- After establishing a library account at https://iii.lib.csufresno.edu/patroninfo, items can be renewed through the Library's website at www.csufresno.edu/library.
- Materials may also be brought in to the Circulation Desk for renewal. (Material requested by another patron may be recalled from a borrower at any time.)
